Checklist

Planning Your Video

- Pick a theme.
What story do you want to tell?
- Are you going to make a custom part?
If so, design and document your part.
CFP Rules Section V
- Make a storyboard.
- Write a script.
Time your script. The video must be 1-5 minutes.
CFP Rules Section V
- Self-evaluate with the rubric.
Score yourself on the rubric and modify your script to get more points.
2019 Rubric
- Check for C-STEM Content.
Ask your teacher to review the script for C-STEM Content
CFP Rules Section III
- Make your props and backdrops.

Writing Code

- Write pseudocode.
In plain English, what will your code do step by step?
- Save a Ch file for each scene.
Add the required headers
CFP Rules Section VI
- Write your code using your pseudocode and script.
Write comments as you code!

Editing Your Video

- Are you using music you did not create?
Make sure you have permission to use the music
CFP Rules Section III
- Add titles and credits.
Titles: video/scene title and school name (up to 5 seconds)
Credits: students, school, teacher, Ch files, permissions (up to 15 seconds)
No scrolling text.

Uploading To Youtube

- Ask your teacher to view your video before uploading it.
- Upload your video with the required metadata
Important: Make sure the video is public and embeddable

Uploading To Scoreboard

- Give your teacher all the files to upload
Script, Ch files, video file
Custom part documentation if you made a custom part
Video file must be under 150 MB
